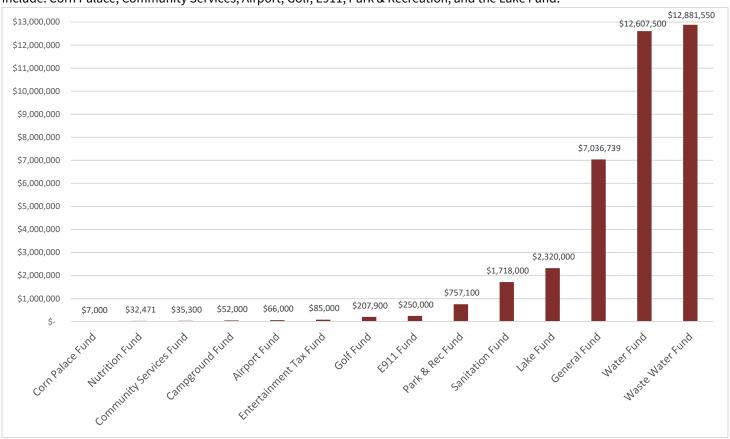

November 15th: 2nd Reading & Adoption.

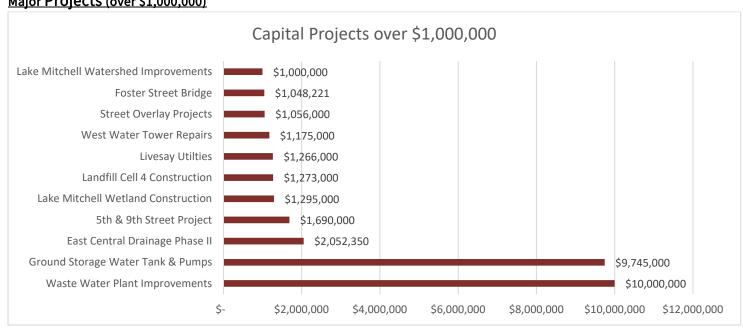
Overview:

The 2022 proposed budget includes \$38,788,660 in capital improvement projects (*includes professional design/planning). Of those projects, \$27,539,950 are in enterprise fund budgets, \$3,479,871 are in special revenue fund budgets, and \$7,036,739 are in the General Fund Budget. It should be noted that some special revenue & enterprise fund capital projects required general fund support in order to complete the projects listed below. Those funds requiring general fund support for Capital Projects in 2022 include: Corn Palace, Community Services, Airport, Golf, E911, Park & Recreation, and the Lake Fund.



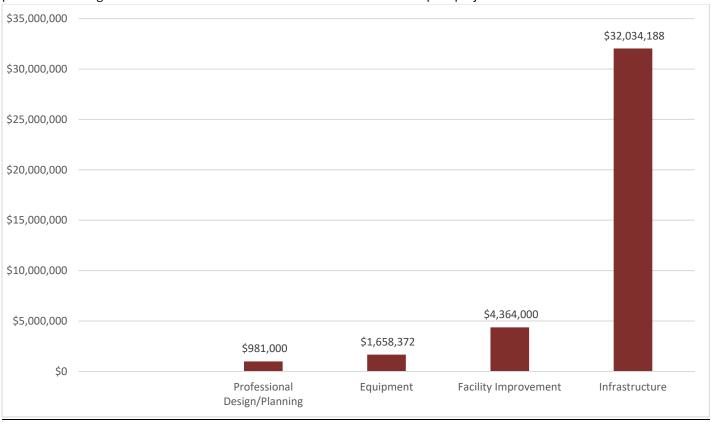

Breakdown of Budget for Capital Projects

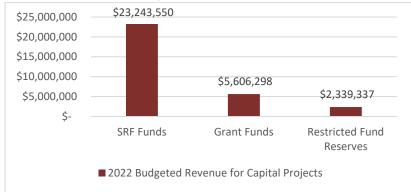

Projects with SRF Bond Financing

The 2022 Requested Budget includes \$23,243,550 in projects that include budgeted revenue for funds to be received through the State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan. The debt service is paid for out of a "surcharge" established in the utility accounts that were recently approved by City Council as part of the 2020-2021 rate review for future utility projects.

- \$750,000 in SRF Funding for the Daily Drive Lift Station Project
- \$377,550 in SRF funding for the East Central Drainage Project
- \$9,745,000 for the Ground Storage Water Tank & Pumps
- \$1,196,000 for the Livesay Utilities Project
- \$10,000,000 for the Waste Water Plant Improvements
- \$1,175,000 for the West Water Tower Repairs

Projects Receiving Grant Support

The 2022 Annual Budget includes \$5,606,298 in grant revenue towards the projects listed below.

- \$324,000 from State grant funds towards the Landfill Cell 4 Construction
- \$1,484,800 from the Federal Economic Development Association (EDA) Grant funds towards East Central Drainage
 Project
- \$674,977 from the State of SD Bridge Improvement Grant (BIG) grant funds towards the Foster Bridge Project
- \$1,000,000 from NAWCA Grant funds towards the Lake Mitchell Watershed Projects.
- \$390,000 from the State Recreational Trails grant program towards the Norway Sidewalk Project
- \$1,295,000 from the Non-Point Source Grant Funds (from the City's designated State Revolving Loan Fund Projects) for the Lake Mitchell Wetland Construction.
- \$140,000 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) grant funds towards the Environmental & Design for the Airport Runway.
- \$68,000 donation towards the Kiwanis Park Expansion n Expansion.
- \$94,000 from the State Recreational Trails Grant program towards the Dry Run Creek Lighting Project.
- \$32,471 from the State Grant Funds for Kitchen Equipment at the James Community Center.
